We have been providing morning snacks for infants for many years. These have included biscuits, toast, crumpets, cereal bars and fruit. Parents have paid only £1 per week (20p per day) and all children have been catered for.

This September, we have started providing mid-morning snacks for all classes from Reception to Year 6.



As well as providing varied snacks at breaktime, this will help to save families money as we can buy in bulk at a much cheaper price and prepare hot snacks when the weather is cold.
