### Our On-Site School

**Our school is closed on Monday.** Our emergency on-site school is for vulnerable children and children of key workers who cannot be looked after at home. On Monday we need to check work identification badges and a printed or electronic wage slip, so please present them when you drop your child off at the front door of the school. We need to see your name and employee number but you are welcome to anonymise salary and personal details.



We would appeal to parents on the 'key worker' list to follow the first principle of keeping their children at home, if it is at all possible. Only send your children in if there is no safe alternative. The 'key worker' list is extensive and challenges the process of social distancing and isolation. Over 130 of our children live in families with key workers - fabulous that St Peter and St Paul's families are doing so much for our community but extremely challenging for school under these circumstances.

Many thanks to the key workers who have done all they can to limit their children's time at school already by providing us with detailed shift information.

Uniform is optional on Monday and packed lunches should be brought in by all except those registered with the council as being entitled to a free school meal. Infants not registered, should bring a packed lunch.

Children will complete the work set on the website during the morning and will be provided with other activities in the afternoons. If children need to use another emergency site, we will let you know at the end of each day. On Monday, we will only be using staff from St Peter and St Paul's, this may change, depending on levels of staff absence.

Many of our key workers will be working over this weekend, increasing their shifts and working round the clock. Never before have we appreciated you more. Many thanks for everything you are doing to help us and this country through this unprecedented crisis.

If you are entitled to a free school meal, packed lunches will be available to be collected at 12 noon.

PE kits and personal possessions left in school can be collected in the weeks ahead. We will let you know when this is happening.

We will think of you all over the coming weeks and will stay in touch by email, text, app, telephone and website. If you have any concerns, needs or worries, please contact us. We are here for you and will do all we can to help or put you in touch with someone who can.
