We have been looking after the children of key workers and those in vulnerable groups for two months. The government have now asked schools to start to bring back groups of children from Reception, Year 1 and Year 6. Teaching unions have raised concerns about how safe this is for children, families and staff and have asked the government for further scientific information. We will update you as soon as we know more about when Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 will be returning. The Education Minister has said that the key worker list will be updated on 31st May and we currently have no idea which occupations will be included. On 1st June we are planning to open for current key worker and vulnerable children only. These children need to book a place in advance by ringing or emailing school. We will update you as soon as we know more. Many thanks for your continued support.

We intend to close for the May half-term break. Key workers requiring emergency childcare should contact school next week, and we will try to arrange an alternative childcare site.
