September Update

The government released guidelines yesterday about how it would like schools to return in September. It is saying that it would like all children to return in bubbles without social distancing between children.

Staff are still advised to follow social distancing and are asked to keep bubbles of children separate as much as possible. The government is also advising staggered starts, finishes, breaks and lunchtimes. It is recommending full school uniform and a broad and balanced curriculum.

Tests for Covid 19 will be available on site and all in contact with anyone with a confirmed case will be asked to self-isolate. School governors, the Local Authority, Archdiocese and unions will now read this guidance carefully to see how practical and safe they feel it is before any decisions are made.
